FirstLight MA Hydro LLC (FERC No. 1889) and Northfield Mountain LLC (FERC No. 2485) (formerly both projects under FirstLight Hydro Generating Company) (collectively, "FirstLight") hereby submits the Massachusetts Phase II archaeological report in accordance with FERC's May 13, 2019 letter granting an extension of time to file the Phase II archaeological study report for Massachusetts by October 18, 2019. Since FERC's May 13, 2019 letter granting an extension of time, FirstLight has submitted progress reports for the Phase II archaeology evaluations on a monthly basis.

On behalf of FirstLight, TRC conducted Phase II archaeological evaluations from July 2019 through August 2019 at 17 archaeological sites located in the Towns of Northfield, Gill, and Greenfield in Franklin County, Massachusetts. The Massachusetts Phase II archaeological report is also being submitted to the Massachusetts Historical Commission (MHC) by letter dated October 18, 2019 for their review.

Because this filing identifies the location of lands that contain protected archaeological resources, FirstLight is filing the Phase II archaeological report as "privileged."<sup>1</sup>
