## Secretary Bose,

Over the course of the past several months, FirstLight has engaged resource agencies and other stakeholders in renewed discussions on outstanding issues pertaining to fish passage, flow proposals, and recreation with an intention of seeking a comprehensive settlement agreement. On August 3, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) outlined these efforts and requested a delay in FERC's issuance of its Notice of Acceptance and Ready for Environmental Analysis until November 12, 2021.

We support DEP's request and would welcome the additional time to continue working with stakeholders to reach an agreement on the outstanding issues. As the DEP pointed out in its letter, FERC's policy favors settlement, and we believe that the additional time could result in meaningful progress ultimately leading to a beneficial outcome. Therefore, we echo DEP's request that FERC defer the issuance of the Notice of Acceptance and Ready for Environmental Analysis until November 12, 2021. We anticipate providing the Commission a report on the parties' progress at that time.
